Equipping the Believer:

- Providing Spirit-led mentorship and spiritual guidance for youth and their families as they grow in faith.
- Recruiting and training dedicated volunteers and interns to cultivate a servant-hearted culture of mentorship.
- Offering opportunities for youth to apply biblical truths and strengthen their foundation in Christ.

Engaging the World:

- Empowering youth to live out their faith authentically in their schools, homes, and communities.
- Encouraging youth to identify and use their spiritual gifts in service to others.
- Keeping parents and quardians informed and involved in their children's spiritual journey.

Organizational and Collaborative Leadership:
